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The Story...

The Pepe family estate was founded in 1899 and for much of that time it was dedicated to growing high yields of grapes to sell to a local co-op. It was only in 1964 that Emidio Pepe decided that the quality of their grapes was too good to waste and moved towards producing their own wines. Back then, this was limited to just a single hectare of vines. Today it stands at around 17 hectares.

While Pepe's wines today are produced using painstakingly precise organic and biodynamic techniques, in the 1960s he initially tried to be ahead of the game, buying the latest and most innovative machinery. But he soon realised that this would mean constantly upgrading his machines to meet the demands of a local market known for its cheap, bland, and young wines. Instead, he took a leap of faith and developed his own philosophy of winemaking - much to the derision of other winemakers at the time, many of whom, understandably, were awestruck by the rapid modernisation of farming technology.

While his wines today represent some of the best in the region, his early vintages found little appreciation, especially in Italy. In fact, it was only after a trip to New York that he found a market - an early stepping-stone towards the international reputation he has today.

The Place..

Abruzzo, Italy

Nestled between the hills, the Adriatic Sea and the Apennine Mountains, the terroir is perfect for the Montepulciano and Trebbiano grapes that are grown there. The vines are trained up pergolas, which allows the leaves to soak up the hot summer sun, while the grapes hang below in the cooler shade. This technique also allows better airflow around the plants. The soil, mainly of clay and calcareous rock, is maintained using traditional methods, the grapes are picked by hand, and treatments using synthetic chemicals are strictly avoided.

The Emidio Pepe estate is a family affair, with Emidio working alongside his daughters Sofia and Daniela as well as his granddaughters Chiara and Elisa. His other daughter, Stefania, runs her own winery. The terroir they work on is in the hills, between the Adriatic Sea and the Apennine Mountains, creating excellent conditions for the Montepulciano and Trebbiano grapes that grow there.

The project began when Yvonne and her husband, René, bought 16 hectares of land at the top of a hill in the village of Laroïn, southwest France. They rebuilt the pile of rubble at the top of the hill into a manse and lived happily there for several years with their family until René sadly passed away. They had always talked about starting their own vineyard there but had never quite got round to it. So, in memory

of her late husband, Yvonne Hegoburu started planting vines.

The first wine Hegoburu produced was so good that it won an award in Paris in 1990. It was not long before she discovered the concept of biodynamic winemaking and she became part of a small community of biodynamic winemakers. As of 1994, her land has been certified as biodynamic.

Maxime and Lucie Salharang began planting Gros Manseng, Petit Manseng, and the native Camaralet at Clos Larrouyat in 2011. The domaine sits on a rare band of Triassic limestone that runs through part of the appellation, marking its wines with a distinctive saline signature.

Clos Larrouyat is known for its powerful fine wines, which are made using biodynamic principles with the utmost respect for both grape and soil.

The domaine produces two Jurançon sec bottlings and one *moelleux*. "Météore" captures the citrusy zip of Petit Manseng (40%) & Gros Manseng (60%) with total charm; "Comète" emphasises the nerve, concentration, and exotic perfume of Petit Manseng; and "Phoenix" is all about the ravishing finesse of late-harvested fruit dried on the vine.

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The name Domaine Causse Marines is derived from the domain's geography: Causse after the rocky plateau of limestone and calcareous soil on which the vines grow, and Marines, the name of the river that flows by the estate. Patrice Lescarret started the winery in 1993; he took over from a retiring farmer who grew crops and sold all his grapes to the local Coop.

Patrice Lescarret studied oenology in Bordeaux and jokes that after learning the wrong way around in the school and being paid for a few years to apply this conventional winemaking in other wineries, he now tries to vinify the right way. Patrice does all the work himself.

Matthieu Cosse and Catherine Maisonneuve created Domaine Cosse Maisonneuve in 1999. Both winemakers and oenologists, they took over a 5-hectare estate in Prayssac, near Cahors, and planted it with 40-year-old Malbec (or "cot") vines. Using biodynamic principles, they set out to make wines that genuinely reflected their place of origin. Their first vintage was Les Laquet, grown in a soil of red clay and Jurassic limestone, cultivated using biodynamic principles, harvested by hand and crushed by foot. They were aged in

barrels for 12 to 22 months before being bottled without filtration.

The estate is made up of 15 hectares of vineyards; Malbec is planted alongside other grape varieties, such as Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Gamay. The domain has a wide range of plots with different soils - clay, limestone and calcareous gravel. Some plots even overhang the River Lot. Tasting a wine from Domaine Cosse Maisonneuve allows you to experience something truly unique, a genuine taste of the Cahors terroir.

Renowned Riojan winemaker Olivier Rivière has crossed over the Pyrenees and is back in Bordeaux. More specifically, Côtes de Bourg, where he has just produced his first cuvée from biodynamically farmed Merlot vines. Named after his daughter, Edina, his first ever cuvée is a nod to the

first ever land of bounty - the Garden of Eden. His intentions are to restore the vines using biodynamic practices (and a lot of hard work) to their greatest potential...

Founded in 2007 by owner Fabrice Domercq and Jasper Morrison, Ormiale is situated in the north of the Entre-Deux-Mers region of Bordeaux. Ormiale is vinified and bottled on the property as an appellation Bordeaux contrôlée – Grand Vin de Bordeaux. While the Merlotinox an 100% Merlot, is a stunning Vin de France wine.

Everything is done by hand, even de-stemming the grapes! These delicately handled grapes are vinified in French oak vats and also in stainless steel vats for about 4 to 5 weeks. Yields are typically, around 20-25 hectolitres/hectare. In comparison, the maximum authorised yield for Bordeaux Supérieur in 2009 was 59 hl./ha! If you think you know your Bordeaux wines Ormiale may prove you wrong!

Steeped in history, Le Puy was first built in the early 17th century. Despite the march of time, production here harks back to an older era. Unlike most Bordeaux wines, which are blended from several grapes, this estate crushes grape varieties together allowing the indigenous yeasts from different parcels and grapes to combine. This provides an extra layer of complexity during their natural fermentation process. These wines are capable of maturing for decades.

From 1990, Le Puy started to move towards sulphite-free vinification, with an extra focus on using only carefully selected grapes without added sulphites, sugars or yeasts, and then allowing the wine to barrel mature for 24 months, with regular stirring in accordance with the lunar calendar. No filtration or fining takes place. This process was implemented in full from the 1998 vintage. As such, they are certified biodynamic by Demeter.

RED — “BARTHÉLÉMY” — MERLOT BLEND

The fruit of the vine plot known as 'Les Rocs', planted with 85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, the Barthélémy undergoes a long vinification process with no added substances. The wines are matured in oak barrels for 24 months, without technical interventions, optimised with reference to the lunar calendar and with no added sulphur dioxide or other chemical products. They are then bottled without filtration.

RED — “RETOUR DES ÎLES” — MERLOT BLEND

The “Retour des îles” casks set sail from Douarnenez in Brittany, travelling down the Spanish coast, the first stop off is at Lisbon, Portugal. They continue along their way as far as Cape Verde and set off to take the Atlantic Ocean by storm. After a short stopover at Bélem in Brazil, they sail back up to the Caribbean with a stop in Barbados and Dominican Republic. They leave the warm waters to head for the Azores and then Falmouth in the United Kingdom. The journey could end there but, keen to explore the world, the wines sail back up the North Sea as far as Amsterdam and Copenhagen. Having had their fill of sea air and gorgeous landscapes they finally returned to Douarnenez. A year later “Retour des îles” is bottled.

The story began in 2001 when Bretaudeau took over a two-hectare family estate in Gétigné. Back then, he could only work weekends and holidays. By 2005, he had expanded to six hectares, the year of his first vintage, and by 2009 he had converted to organic production. Today, Domaine De Bellevue has nine hectares of vineyards, spread across various appellations

and towns: Gétigné, Cugand, Clisson and Vallet.

Jérôme Bretaudeau is one of a small handful of serious, winemakers devoted to the compelling terroir of Muscadet. Jérôme is known for his extravagance, both in the grape varieties he cultivates and in the winemaking techniques he uses.

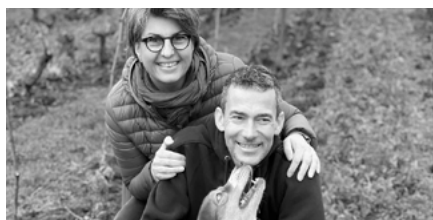
An agronomist by trade, Thomas, spent his formative years working in Champagne, Burgundy, Provence and California before settling down in the schist-rich lands of Anjou Noir with his partner Charlotte in 2008. Together they started Terre De l'Élu (formerly known as Clos de l'Élu), which tends to eight different grape varieties, covering 20 hectares of organically farmed land in the heart of the Loire.

In 2018, the duo decided to relinquish the word "Clos" which is reserved only for appellation wines. Due to the restrictions imposed under the appellation rules, Charlotte and Thomas say "we prefer to give priority to our freedom and creativity rather than trying to make wines that do not resemble us."

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Coulée de Serrant was planted in the 12th Century by Cistercian monks and has remained in vine ever since. The wealth of history oozes from this special place lying next to the fortress Roche-au-Moines, a site of a key battle in the Anglo-French War of 1214. At this point, the domain was already celebrating its 84th vintage.

Louis XI is said to have nicknamed it '*a drop of gold*' and Empress Josephine 'loved' the wine. Famous French writers such as Alexandre Dumas, Maurice Constantin Weyer are also known to have been fans of these great wines. Today the estate continues to be

known for its outstanding wines but is also known for its current custodians - Nicolas Joly - the godfather of biodynamics and his daughter Virginie.

The Joly family-run the 7-hectare estate which is cultivated by hand and by horse overlooking the Loire river. Every aspect of production is considered and natural. Herbicides have not been used here for decades, and medicinal plants such as yarrow, chamomile, stinging nettle, oak, dandelion and valerian are used as homoeopathic remedies instead of harmful chemicals.

Bruno Ciofi started his career as a wine-maker at Domaine Pierre Frick, (one of the pioneers of biodynamic farming and natural wine making in Alsace). After 13 years of experience with Jean-Pierre Frick, Bruno moved to Arbois (Jura) in 2008 and he had worked for Domaine de la Pinte until 2016. Bruno brought biodynamic farming to the vineyards in 2009 (Domaine de la Pinte has been organic since 1999).

After moving to Anjou to start a new life with his wife Virginie (daughter of Nicolas Joly) Bruno founded "Béret et Compagnie" on his own to work as a negociant and assist small producers in the Loire Valley who make wine naturally, but who do not have the resources to independently bottle or commercialize their wines. Béret et Compagnie selects only grapes or wines from biodynamic/biologic vineyards, and also supports converting their vineyards from conventional farming to natural farming.

Julien Courtois created his own vineyard, Le Clos de la Bruyère, in 1998, having learned the trade from his father, Claude. The 4.5 hectare domain in Soings en Sologne is run by Julien and his girlfriend, Heidi Kuka. Here they work with seven varieties of grapes, including an ungrafted Orbois, planted in 1978, which is used to make the Original wine.

Julien and his father have always kept to the principles of making wines from low-yield vineyards, allowing them to reach the optimum concentration, and working on the basis of natural cycles. This means that the harvest takes place at the point of the grapes' peak maturity, and all by hand. Chemical treatment for the vines is avoided, with plant-based mixtures used instead.

After having trained as an accountant, Reynald Héaulé quickly decided to follow the call of winemaking. He was tutored by Claude Courtois, and, like his mentor, is known for his unusual selection of grapes, including Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay, Gascon and Pinot Gris.

Héaulé started out in Burgundy before setting up a small scale vineyard by the river Loire back in 2000. He can now boast of three hectares, which he plants himself, and 20 varieties of vine. These are grown in high density, at around 12,500 vines per hectare, across a range of soil types – including that of a mineral-rich former river bed.

The wines produced by Francis and Delphine Boulard owe a lot to Francis' grandfather, who would often talk about the importance of the moon when planting and working the soil. Boulard's three-hectare estate is, therefore, run using age-old methods that are in line with nature and seasonal rhythms.

The harvests are timed in such a way as to produce sugar in high concentrations. The grapes are pressed immediately afterwards using a membrane press. The grapes from

the various terroirs, plots and varieties are carefully kept separate from one another, allowing the resulting wines to reach their maximum complexity. The fermentation process is carried out entirely naturally, using only the indigenous yeasts found on the grapes themselves. This fermentation takes place in either wooden vats, half hogsheads or 300-litre oak barrels. This allows for each fermentation to be individually tailored depending on grape variety and plot.

Franck is famous for his natural approach to winemaking. He began to transform the estate's methodology in 1998, and by 2007 he was officially certified as an organic producer. In fact, he goes much further than many others in attempting to create the perfect wine, bringing in not just natural, organic and biodynamic principles but also naturopathic ideas more commonly associated with acupuncture. This involves considering the energy levels in

living things, from the vine to the soil itself. Treating the vines in this way, he believes, gives them the ability to reach their full potential. He even convinced his compost producer to create a new form of fertiliser, based on lab analysis of his own soil. It contains volcanic sulphur, which allows the liberation of elements that are usually trapped in the limestone. This is one way of recovering the microorganisms often lost after years of conventional farming.

In 1988, Frédéric took over the 1.5 hectares of vines that his grandfather, Marius Genton, had maintained. The vineyards have been gradually enriched by new grape varieties, drawing on the wealth of existing Savoyard varieties.

Frédéric Giachino has been producing wine in his domain for more than 20 years, utilising organic techniques for half of that time.

The vines grow on the Chartreuse Hills, along the slopes of Mount Granier. The soil here is a result of an ancient tragedy. In 1248, a huge landslide sent 500 million square metres of rock crashing down onto the surrounding villages, destroying five of them. The soil today, rich in limestone and clay, is made up of that rock. It is quite remarkable that such conditions can lead to such excellent wines.

Evelyne and Pascal have run this domain since 1991, and one of the things that stands out most is perhaps their meticulous approach to quality control of the grapes. After picking, grapes are loaded into 20kg containers, which are then transported by sledge. This might sound trivial, but it means that there is rarely any need to add sulphur to compensate for grape damage.

Plantation is achieved by selective breeding, rather than grafting, across their six hectares of land. The domain is free of synthetic chemicals, with compost and manure used to condition the marl and clay soil; sulphur, horn-manure, Bouillie Bordelaise and other biodynamic materials, are used to increase grape quality. The grapes are destemmed by hand. Although the domain was certified organic only in 2010, it had been operating to organic standards long before then.

Cushioned between the rolling vineyards of Wintzenheim in Alsace, Domaine Josmeyer has been making wines for five generations dating back to 1854. 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The Béru family have owned the estate for 400 years, and even writings by 9th-century monks note the vineyards growing here. It was during the Middle Ages that the wines here received international appreciation, often appearing on royal tables.

Despite its long history, current owners Laurence de Béru and her daughter, Athénaïs, were aware that the soil was

fragile. Since 2005, only organic methods have been used on the estate, and from 2010 they began to convert to biodynamic practices. Now only a limited amount of natural chemical intervention is used, such as treatment with sulphur, and a horse-drawn plough prepares the soil. It's no wonder the estate continues to build on its already steadfast reputation.

Fanny Sabre didn't plan to be a winemaker. She was at university studying law when her father died, and she took over the running of the estate. Initially, it was with the help of natural wine pioneer Philippe Pacalet who stepped in to help following Fanny's father's death. He taught Fanny how to farm organically. The grapes are all grown organically and

harvested manually. Manual ploughing takes place between the rows of vines, which are sprayed only with organic mixtures. No herbicides are used. The wines are produced on a small scale, with each vine monitored closely and with meticulous attention to detail in the cellar. No synthetic chemicals are added, with natural treatments used instead during the process.

Part of Giboulot's love of his organic methods perhaps comes from the fact that he has never done it any differently. He learnt his craft from his father, who ran the estate on an organic basis since 1975 and took over production in 1985 with just a single hectare of land. It was certified biodynamic in 1996. His vines grow in soils of clay and chalk, at 280 to 400 metres elevation. Only indigenous yeast is used in production, which is based firmly on the schedule of the lunar month. He does not

stir the lees and prefers the wine to reach its own level of quality with minimum intervention. He even uses a mechanical screw press rather than a pneumatic equivalent.

As a result of this care and attention to wines and principles, Giboulot's wines are balanced, precise and elegant.

The initial reason why Daniel and H  l  ne Boulle decided to convert to organic and biodynamic wine production was their attempt to use natural methods in order to treat their son's eczema (as good a reason as any). They received their Biodivin certification and their Ecocert in 2007, five years after starting to move away from conventional methods.

The 30 hectares Domaine Les Aphillantes, near Gigondas in the Rhône Valley, is now

famed for its low level of intervention, creating wines with a fine minerality that truly express the terroir. Well known for their quality of fruit, Daniel and Hélène keep only the finest 80 per cent of grapes produced and they sell the rest. They tend to limit themselves to 130,000 bottles every year and produce yields of about 25-30hl/ha, significantly less than the locally allowed 45hl/ha. In fact, the domain is so committed to quality, it is even prepared to skip a vintage entirely if it is not up to standard.

This estate dates back to the 17th century and takes its name from a nearby river, which helps to provide an environment of wet subsoil. This means that the vines endure less heat during the summer, resulting in delicate and elegant red wines produced using only biodynamic methods.

Domaine Milan was created in 1956 by Robert Milan, Henri's father. It was here that Henri planted his first vine at the age of eight. Back then, the land was used for conventional farming methods. This was one of the big changes that were heralded when Henri took over in 1984. The land had been spoiled by excessive synthetic chemical treatments during the 1970s and early 1980s, so it was at this point the younger Milan moved towards organic production.

The appellation of Vin De France does not allow producers to display the vintage of a wine on its label, which is why you will note Roman numerals on the bottle of Domaine Milan VDF instead. It could be said that this rebelliousness is typical of Henri Milan. He broke away from Baux De Provence AOC so that he could have more freedom to produce the wines he wanted to make.

If it wasn't for Antoine Abbattu, most of the grapes now grown by Jean-Charles, Antoine's son, may not exist. In the 1960s, local Corsican grapes were being rapidly replaced by international competitors. Antoine was charged with preserving these varieties and, using a hectare of land, created an ampelographic station and saved the fate of 18 of them. When Jean-Charles took over in 2000 he converted the estate to biodynamics. He

then began to graft some of these old varieties onto their existing vines. Today, 14 of those varieties can be found at Domaine Abbattu, situated in the Taravo Valley, just south of Ajaccio, the capital of Corsica. The estate produces around 1,500 bottles of each type of wine, so you'll have to hurry if you want to experience the unique qualities of grapes that were virtually raised from the dead.

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Stéphanie and Frédéric met in Montpellier in 1999 as they were both studying winemaking and oenology. After being provided with training from biodynamic winemakers such as Sylvain Fadat and Xavier Peyraud, they united forces to take their next step together.

In 2004, Stéphanie and Fred decided to isolate 8 hectares of the Mas Nicot vineyard,

which has been in Stéphanie's family since 1773. Here they make their own wine using biodynamic farming, focusing on low yields and producing around 8000 bottles of "La Marèle" – a natural wine, which could not be more expressive, subtle and lively.

Alain Chabanon is the child of two teachers. He studied agronomy, but after a work placement on a vineyard, changed career course to focus on winemaking.

At first Alain worked alongside Alain Brumont from Madiran, and directed a wine producers' co-operative in the Gard. It was only after he posted a wanted advert

in the late-1980s that he found a plot in Montpeyroux suitable for his needs.

The estate has changed little since the first vintage in 1992. It was around the village of Montpeyroux that Alain found the type of vines that he was looking for: "Old vines, because to make great wines you need old vines. The sap takes longer to rise, and concentrates the aromas."

A trained sommelier and former pupil of Didier Dagueneau, Ludovic went back to his native Languedoc and opened a wine shop. He also bought 1 hectare of old Grenache Noir planted in 1955 and started making a bit of wine on the side.

A few years later, with a few more hectares at his disposal, he sold the shop and went into winemaking full time. His schooling becomes apparent when you taste his wines as he takes Grenache to a level of refinement rarely seen.

The son of a winemaker, Xavier Braujou decided to go against the grain and became a lumberjack. It's only years later, in 1998, after having worked at Daumas Gassac and in Alsace, that he heard the calling. Since then, he's acquired about 12 hectares of old grape varieties typical of the region.

He practices *Selection Massale* and is one of the last to do his own field grafts. Working with old bush vines, his yields are quite low and yet the wines are fresh and velvety.

This domain was founded on a biodynamic basis by German film producer Reinhard Brundig in 2002. Brundig was first attracted to the domain due to the complexity of the soil, its established and carefully nurtured vines, and the geographic location, near to Montagne Noire. Now the operation is led by Brunnhilde Claux, whose first vintage was in 2014.

Brunnhilde hand-harvests each variety and plot of land separately. The grapes are hand-selected, and while the young ones are de-stemmed, the older varieties are often used whole. These grape clusters are then layered and pressed by foot to squeeze out

trapped oxygen, before their 9 to 12 days of maceration.

Claux's main drive has been to work the vineyards in order to achieve ripeness at the lowest possible Baume – her aim being to capture as much freshness as possible. This work, combined with Claux's gentle winemaking-infusion rather than extraction – and the complete absence of new oak, has already produced a range of wine that are appreciably livelier, more seductive and fragrant than what we had come to expect of this excellent producer and the Minervois appellation in general.

A *casot* is a stone shelter, many of which can be found around the exposed region of Banyuls. It's in these *casots* that vineyard workers take refuge from the heat, wind and rain - the same elements that work so well for the wines produced here.

Le Casot De Mailloules is one of the smallest vineyards in Banyuls, and was made famous

by Alain Castex and Ghislaine Magnier, who first bought the four-hectare plot in the 1990s, producing the wine in an old Citroen garage. The honour has now been passed on to Jordi Perez, with 2015 being the first vintage he produced himself. His artisanal approach and the difficult and meticulous manual work results each year in a minimalist production of 12,000 bottles.

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The art of winemaking must be in the blood of brothers Benoit and Sébastien Danjou-Banessy – grapes and vines have been a part of their family heritage for generations. In the 1950s, Benoit and Sébastien's grandfather had bought further vineyards and created a "library" of rancios. Benoit worked alongside his grandfather

until they produced their final vintage together in 2000.

The wine production method is fully biodynamic and non-interventionist and has been for generations. All of these factors lead to delicious wines that are lively, elegant and softly textured.

After several years working in New York City, Silvio Messana took over the Montesecondo estate from his father in 1999. Silvio's first vintage was in 2000, and the conversion to organic was certified in 2004. Montesecondo wines have come into conflict with the powers-that-be in Chianti Classico. While Silvio's methods in the vineyard and cellar yield what many consider

pure, classically expressive wines; the way he gets there, and occasionally the results (higher acidity, lighter colour or darker colour, etc.) means that he can only bottle one Chianti Classico and the rest are labelled as IGT Toscana. His wines exhibit incredible freshness, with the ageing done in very old barrels or concrete tanks and clay amphora for his flagship wines.

The breathtakingly beautiful Tenuta Di Valgiano is located in the North of Tuscany, 300 meters above sea level in the Colline Lucchesi appellation overlooking the city of Lucca. It has been a wine estate since the 16th century, and some of the buildings are almost as old as the estate. The farm covers 40 hectares, 16 of which are vineyards, and another 13 are home to honeybees and olive trees, which produce outstanding olive oil and honey. The Palistorti rosso and the Tenuta Di Valgiano are made of a blend of Sangiovese, Merlot, Syrah, Cilieggiolo and Canaiolo. A bit more

Merlot goes into the blend in cooler vintages, and in warmer vintages, a bit more Syrah is added. Both wines are made in the same way and aged between 12 to 15 months—the main difference between the two lies in the vine age. The vines used for Palistorti are 15 to 20 years of age, whereas the ones for Tenuta are around 35 to 40 years old. While the very limited The Palistorti bianco (a blend of Vermentino, Trebbiano and a little bit of Malvasia) is of such exceptional quality, it's easy to understand why most of it doesn't even leave the country!

The Ampeleia estate began its life in the 1960s when the land was bought by a Swiss couple. In 2002 the estate was taken over by Elisabetta Foradori, Thomas Widmann and Giovanni Podini, who wanted to demonstrate the diversity and potential of the region. Although they own around 120 hectares of land, only 35 hectares

are currently under vine. Spread over 3 distinct altitudes, each with different soils and used to grow different grape varieties. Marco Tait has been responsible for the winemaking since the beginning of the project and continues to do so with minimal intervention, aiming to preserve the essence of the fruit and the expression of the land.

Located 15 kilometres north Barcelona, with just 220 hectares Alella is one of the Spain's smallest and oldest DO's. The proximity to the Mediterranean, granite soils called Sauló, and a plethora of native vines has inspired a few growers to protect this area from extinction. There is no doubt that the quiet revolutionary Oriol Artigas is at the forefront of this movement. Oriol started making wine to enjoy with friends,

but started his project with the 2011 vintage. His overarching philosophy is to "cultivate the vineyards in the most natural and least interventionist way possible, in order to let the grapes express with intensity the soil from which they come from." He has 7.5 hectares of vineyards, with the majority being planted en vaso, which are very old, and located around his hometown Vilassar de Dalt.

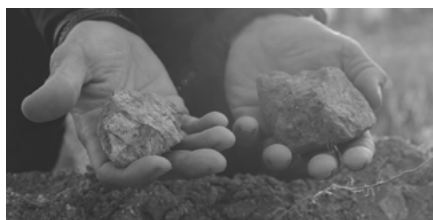
Salvador Batlle Barrabeig cultivates 9.5 ha of Catalan landscape, connected by one focus - decoding terroirs, honouring grapes and interpreting the vines. Each plot sits at varying altitudes between the Pyrenees and the Mediterranean Sea. Salvador farms organically and uses biodynamic practices when necessary, but he prefers to be recognised for his deep respect for the natural environment than to be categorised. Còsmic winemaking is the philosophy of taking care of vines with patience, passion, creativity and freedom.

for vinification and ageing. One could say these are 'modern' Riojas, astonishingly fresh and unoaked.

A stone's throw away from the Atlantic ocean located in Val do Salnés in the north of Rías Baixas, this bodega is owned by the Méndez family. The soil in his vineyards is granitic sand, covered with a layer of humus, over granite bedrock. It is very poor, fast draining soil that vines struggle in and phylloxera cannot live in, hence many of the vineyards are deceptively old, up to

200 years! Even his Albariño comes from vines with an average age of 40 years. The recovery of century-old vineyards of indigenous red varieties, such as Caiño, Espadeiro and Loureiro, in addition to the white Albariño from old vineyards, are the base of their wines and a clear reflection of the terroir: wines full of freshness, with a perfect minerality and ample sensations.

In 1985, Thomas Ligas began to study the local ecosystems, experimenting with viticulture and vinification, and seeking to accentuate the distinctive qualities of his terroir. Thomas and Meli, father and children, work side by side to safeguard the health and maturity of their grapes, seeking an ideal balance between quality and quantity. This natural approach to viticulture preserves the original characteristics of the grape, as determined by the vineyard. They

only grow indigenous Greek varieties, some from the south like Assyrtiko, others nearly forgotten, like Kydonitsa and Limniona. The first performance of the Euripides tragedy Bacchae took place in the Theatre of Dionysus, in Pella, in around 408BC. Bacchus (or Dionysus) was the ancient god of wine and joy, and so it's fitting that Ktima Ligas is using the ancient techniques of this wine-producing region to bring both wine and joy to its customers today.

Domaine de Beudon is a remarkable place – a tiny farm perched on the steep side of the Swiss Alps above the village of Fully, and locally known as the “vineyard in the sky”. “There are two ways to visit us,” explains owner Marion Granges. “One is by small cable car or you can walk for an hour via steep mountain tracks.”

Domaine de Beudon is the only wine grower there. Produced in tiny quantities, from just a 6-hectare estate, Beudon wine very rarely makes it out of Switzerland and onto the international market.

Jean-Denis Perrochet, his wife Christine and son Alexandre, are the minds behind this biodynamic Domaine based in north-western Switzerland in the wine region Neuchâtel. The Perrochet family have deep roots in this area going back over 900 years, with their winemaking beginning in the 17th century. On taking over the estate from his ancestors, Jean-Denis took a biodynamic approach to farming his land

and making his wines - a brave decision in a country where "organic" wines had historically been made in a sloppy manner, causing public opinion to somewhat reject their quality.

Biodynamic practices and sustainable farming methods have resulted in life-filled soils, and beautifully healthy grapes that produce pure wines with finesse and balance.
