<p>Barthélemy (1844-1925) is one of the most illustrious winemakers in the family. He bequeathed his notebooks to us, in which he questioned the use of sulphur in the vinification process.</p> <p>Description: Barthélemy hails from the geologically unique plot of Les Rocs, where 100% Merlot vines thrive. The wine opens with enticing aromas of ripe cherries and succulent plums, leading to a beautifully expressive palate, silky, layered, and complex.
